- To maintain the health and hygiene

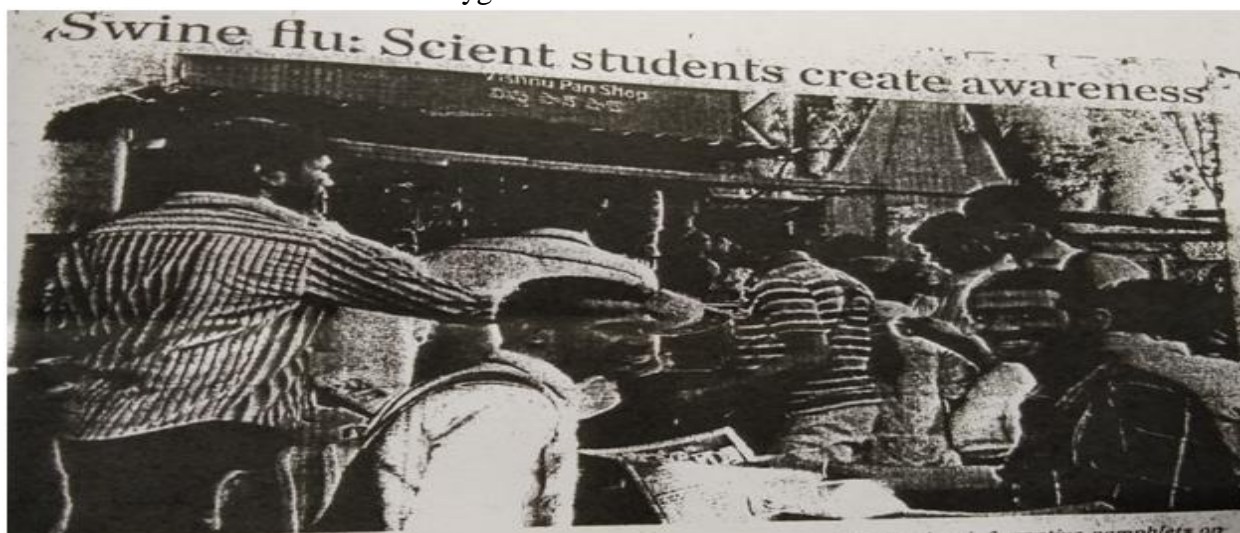


Fig 1 : Awareness on Swine flu

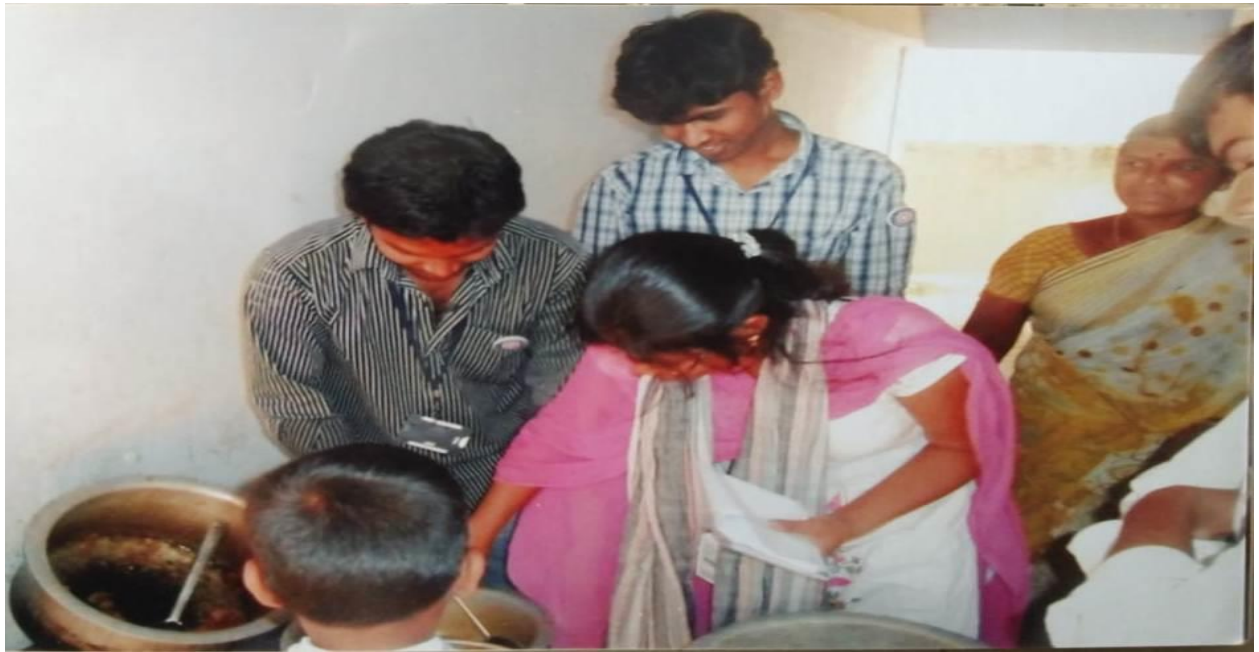
